1. Define your request:

These games and manipulatives help children build foundational understandings of mathematical concepts, build on their mathematical knowledge, and practice mathematical skills in a dynamic and engaging way. These resources will be used to enhance our current curriculum and develop thinking and reasoning skills in the area of Math. Not only will students in the ALP program benefit from these materials on a regular basis, but ALP teachers will use these resources when pushing into classrooms to support in-class Math enrichment.

They can also be used as "Center" activities in the upper level grades for students to practice and develop higher level thinking skills.
