1. Define your request:

On behalf of the Sunset Ridge Learning Center, I am requesting funding to expand our collection of board games. The Sunset Ridge Learning Center is a hub of student activity before school, during recess, and after school. Our current board game collection is small, but it is well loved! The LC board game collection is heavily utilized and brings our students together in a fun, productive manner. I would love to purchase more current, educational, and innovative games for our students to use during their time in the Learning Center.

3. Can this project be funded in stages? If yes, what timetable is involved? If no, please explain your due date for funds.

Yes. This will be an ongoing project throughout the 2017-2018 school year. In the meantime, I have been collecting family donations for board games and have brought many from my personal collection at home. This project could be funded in two stages (one in the fall or one in the spring), or it could all be funded at one time. New games can all be introduced at once, or I can put out a few every week to give our students the opportunity to play with new games gradually.

4. Has this request been reviewed by the school administration? What was their response as to its merit and priority?

Yes. Dr. Sukenik has been an enthusiastic supporter of the Learning Center's growing board game collection. She has expressed that it encourages students to unplug and collaborate face to face. Dr. Sukenik encouraged me to submit this request, especially as more students will be utilizing the LC during indoor recess in the upcoming winter and spring.

5. Number of Students that will be impacted or benefit from your request:

This request will impact the entire SRS student body. All students who utilize the Learning Center will have access to these games before school, during recess, and afterschool. We currently have regular groups of students who visit the LC during these times, which ranges anywhere from 10-80 students per day.

Is this a one-time request or do you envision needing additional PTO funds in the future or long range? If you will require additional PTO funds, please explain why this cannot be added into your annual budget.

This is a one-time request. In the future, board games will likely need replaced or replenished, but my current goal is to build a solid foundation for our collection.

The intended goal of this request is to build up our board game collection for student use before school, during recess, and afterschool. Through playing games, students are developing critical thinking skills, communication skills, collaboration skills, and having fun! Teachers throughout SRS are more than welcome to borrow games from the Learning Center at any time. Many of the games purchased with this money will be student suggestions, but I will also send a form for teachers to request specific educational games that coincide with their curricular goals. This will enhance our existing board game collection, which is very small and constantly utilized by our students.


8. What are the long range benefits of your request?
